



Buckingham County Elementary School is excited to offer students and their families participation in the **21st Century Community Learning Center.**

Out Of School Time Programming

Beyond the Bell will give students the opportunity to take part in homework help, tutoring, library services, enrichment, and recreation activities during out of school time. While we are in phased instruction, all programming will take place remotely including virtual (real-time), remote (accessible via jump drives), and take-home project based learning activities.

Family members will be invited to fun family engagement events, parent workshops, and all Beyond the Bell family events. While the school division is in phased instruction, all family programming will take place remotely including virtual (real-time), remote (accessible via jump drives), and take-home project based learning activities.

Spaces are limited and will be filled with a first come, first serve; while priority will be given to students who sign up for at least 2 classes a week and students who demonstrate an academic need for tutoring or remediation support. Students who participate regularly in the Beyond the Bell school year program will have priority access to the spring and summer programs.

Homework help and library book pickup will be available Monday - Friday from 7:00am - 7:45am. Homework help will be provided through Google Meets where students and/or parents can connect in real-time with a school staff member. Staff will be available by phone for those students without internet access.

After school remediation will be offered on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. Enrichment activities will be offered on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons while the school division is in phased instruction. When schools are in the reopening phases, we will be altering our programming to reflect both in person and remote instruction for participants. This programming will include homework help sessions, tutoring, enrichment, as well as extended parent pick up times with homework help and library services. Courses offered include: Quick Start Tennis, Drama, Art Classes, STEM, H.A.P.P.Y. Group and much more!!

Virtual Program Orientation will be held during the weeks of September 14 - 21st. Upon acceptance into the program, you will receive a copy of the participant handbook and an invitation

to schedule your orientation. All participants and a family member are required to attend an orientation. During the orientation, program coordinators will answer any questions you may have about the expectations and requirements as a Beyond the Bell participating family. Families that do not have internet access to join a virtual session will schedule orientation phone calls with the Coordinators. Failure to attend an orientation during the scheduled window will result in removal from the program until the orientation is complete.

The program will begin on Wednesday 9/9/20.

We look forward to having your child join us in this exciting opportunity.

The Beyond the Bell program is offered free of charge to all participants and their family members. It is being funded with a three year 21st CCLC grant. We will work in collaboration with our community partners from: Virginia Cooperative Extension-4H, Parks and Recreation, James River State Park, and Peter Francisco Soil and Water Conservation. We will also offer programs for students and families with support from our stakeholders from South Central Counseling Group.

The Beyond the Bell program is a 21st Century Community Learning Center. This program is being funded with a 3 year federal 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant administered by the state of Virginia. We are excited to start our **second year** of operation and look forward to your child joining the Beyond the Bell program!!!!
